TO THE APPLICANT: This is a development agreement application as authorized by Chapter 17.102 of Ordinance No. 1160 N.S., Title 17, Colville Municipal Code. Please complete the application in its entirety.

The application shall be accompanied by a receipt from the City Treasurer in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for payment of the application fee, along with a sketch map showing the property for which the general land use application is sought, and the names and addresses of property owners within 300 feet, not including street rights-of-way, of the boundaries of the property as shown on the most recent County Assessor's records. The applicant shall provide addressed, pre-stamped envelopes.

Pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act (WAC 197-11), an environmental checklist shall be completed and submitted along with a receipt from the City Treasurer in the amount of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125). Required publication of the threshold determination will be at cost at the applicant's expense.
