

FIREWORKS PERMITS

Fireworks may be discharged within the City limit of the City of Colville on July 4th between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. and December 31st from 6:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. on January 1st of the subsequent year.

The City of Colville requires that anyone selling fireworks within the City limits must obtain a permit.

Only fireworks meeting the definition of RCW 70.77.136 (otherwise known as safe and sane) are legal for sale to the public.

Fireworks may only be sold between 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. July 1st through July 3rd, until 7:00 p.m. on July 4th and from 12:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. on December 27th through December 31st.

All vendors must prominently display a copy of their Washington State Fire Marshall's permit at the point of sale.

Violations of this Ordinance shall be a civil infraction enforced by Ordinance 1305 N.S. or any amendments thereof.

Vendors wishing to sell fireworks within the City limits must provide the following to:

- 1) Proof of insurance
- 2) Washington State Fire Marshall's Permit (to be signed by the Colville Fire Chief)
- 3) Written permission from the property owner
- 4) Map of stand location
- 5) \$20.00 fee
