| Wild & Scenic Film Festival, 3/9-11   |   | Mann will contact Tim Coleman regarding the event follow-up form for the three showings.  |
| Spokane Symphony, Music on the Mountain, 9/16                                   | VF Committee members received the contract via email. Shoemaker submitted the briefing sheet, \$1500 (\$3000 requested). She talked with the symphony coordinator about buying a block of tickets for youth and their families, but the coordinator said we could end up with people taking tickets and not using them. The coordinator hasn't replied further to Shoemaker.  |   |
| Doctors' Concert, 8/15  | Kent provided briefing sheet to City Council, which voted to fund it for \$1700.  |   |
| Dance Your Legs Off RAVE UP, 7/29 & 8/26  | VF Committee members received the contract for Royal Red Entertainment, partners, and firm dates via email. Through Dean Fischer the City of Colville Recreation Department requested \$1400. City Council requires a public meeting for the sound variance. McGrane moved to fund the event and ask Mann to provide a briefing sheet for City Council. Kent seconded. Passed unanimously.  | McGrane will ask Mann to contact Fischer that the VF Committee supports the event and if Mann will submit a briefing sheet to City Council. |
| Colville Rendezvous   | McGrane was disappointed the VF Committee is not supporting this event and funding a lot of out of Colville area events. Discussion at the April VF committee meeting included Mann phoning Steve Oswin about potential bands for this year, the performers McGrane and Shoemaker were looking into didn't work out. Kent has a meeting with Oswin tomorrow and will ask if he have a suggestion for 2017 with our remaining funds. | If funding a performer at Rendezvous is a priority for 2018, the VF Committee will need to plan earlier in the year.                        |
| Kettle Falls Camp & Jam   | Shoemaker says we may have more money, as stage for Camp & Jam is currently not ADA compliant. The VF Committee will wait to see if the event occurs.   |   |
